

Mary Burmeister-Jin Shin Jyutsu® Outreach 2008 Update

The Mary Burmeister-Jin Shin Jyutsu Outreach continues to share Jin Shin Jyutsu with needy individuals throughout the world. The Mary Burmeister-Jin Shin Jyutsu Outreach has assisted 36 individuals who have applied for grants in 2008. Students from Brazil, Canada, Germany, Israel, and Singapore have received class grants. We have given class grants to individuals in the US from Arizona, California, Colorado, Kansas, Kentucky, New Jersey, Washington, Wisconsin, Texas and Vermont. Two individuals have received a grant for a series of sessions. We thank our individual donors, instructors and JSJ Inc who all contribute to the Outreach. In 2008 we have received donations in memory of our beloved teacher, Mary Burmeister, who completed her transformation from matter to spirit, and now resides in the joyful and loving hands of our Creator. We have also received an estate donation from a student who completed her transformation from matter to spirit in 2007. All donations are being used to expand the teachings of Mary Burmeister and Jin Shin Jyutsu with the needy throughout the world. Prison inmates in India are continuing to benefit from Jin Shin Jyutsu Self Help as they send in letters describing their experiences with Jin Shin Jyutsu Self Help. One inmate says “I know I can complete my life sentence in prison with the help of Jin Shin Jyutsu.”

.Educational class grants are available for 5 day classes (up to three classes total) and the Living the Art classes (one class) and are based on financial need. All grant applicants are asked to fill out a grant application, write a personal letter telling us about themselves, their interest in Jin Shin Jyutsu and why they are applying for a grant and send a copy of their most recent tax return. Grants are approved by Jin Shin Jyutsu and the Congressional District Programs, the 501(c) 3 public charity we work with. Applicants should allow 4-6 weeks to process grant requests. Grant applicants are encouraged to choose classes in their home areas due to costs of traveling.
