The Mary Burmeister-Jin Shin Jyutsu Foundation and Outreach was founded in 2001. The purpose is to expand the work of Mary Burmeister and the Art of Jin Shin Jyutsu Physio-Philosophy through contributions that support medical research; educational development that creates different avenues of presentation including language translations, implementation of scholarships that base selection on merit, need, or minority status; selection of individuals to receive Jin Shin Jyutsu treatments; financial support for Jin Shin Jyutsu associations, seminars, correspondence courses and outreach programs to developing countries.

The Mary Burmeister-Jin Shin Jyutsu Outreach continues to offer Self Help classes to prisoners. Classes were given to the entire prison population at Bay Correctional Complex in Panama City Florida and to 500 inmates at Bhopal prison in Bhopal, India last year. In 2011, the Outreach supported a Self Help class given to a group of low income women with HIV+ in Bali. A practitioner from New York went to Tuscaloosa, Alabama for one week to give sessions and teach self help classes to those affected by the devastating tornadoes of the spring of 2011 with the support from the Outreach. The Mary Burmeister-Jin Shin Jyutsu Outreach also gave partial and full class grants to individuals in Arizona, California, Kentucky, Michigan, New York, Ohio, Missouri, Wisconsin and Rugby, England.
